We held an assembly on Monday of this week to remind children of the rules about behavior in school, both in class and in the playground. We have tried several ways of minimising issues that can occur during the lunchtime, such as shortening the lunch break and adding in an afternoon break, changing the number of lunchtime sittings, restructuring the lunchtime supervisor cover and trying to find suitable equipment to keep the children occupied. Despite this, there are still a few children for whom lunchtime behavior is persistently less than good. We have shared with the children that persistent episodes of behavior that leads to them being sent into the office will result in a lunchtime sanction with a member of the senior leadership team. A repeat or continuation of such behavior will then lead to parents being invited in to discuss the situation with the child and Mr Hurling/Mrs Leder. Further issues may lead to the child having to be collected at lunchtimes and returned in time for afternoon sessions. If these steps do not see an improvement, we may have to consider fixed term exclusion for persistent disruptive behavior.

We work hard to help the children to manage their behavior; we have a lunchtime nurture club and also give opportunities to sit in with Lego/drawing for those who struggle with lunchtimes outside. We want all of our children to enjoy their break times and welcome your support in this matter.
