Phonics

This week we continue our fantastic phonics sessions and will be learning the next four sounds. Below are some activities to help support you at home in learning these new sounds.

- Can you say these sounds?
- Can you think of any words that start with this sound?
- Can you have a go at writing these letter sounds?

Have a go at saying the sounds in the following words and blending them together to read the word.

Number

Over the last couple of weeks at school we have been looking at the numbers from 0-10.

Counting

- Have a selection of objects. Ask your child to count how many objects there are. Can they match the correct number card? (from their zippy wallet) Repeat this activity using different numbers.

Recognising

Place your child's number cards from their zippy wallet around the house. Say a number and see if your child can find that number.
